

OUR PRIVACY POLICY

We aim to protect your privacy and want to ensure our website and our digital platforms are safe, transparent and understandable.

This Privacy Policy sets out how we collect, hold, use, disclose or change information about you as a site user.

Collection and use of personal information

We do not collect personally identifying information from a user of our website unless you choose to provide it by filling out a form. Details of name, organisation and contact email are collected and used for the purpose for which they were given.

We do not sell, rent or lend any personally identifiable information to third parties or outside agencies.

How do we store and process personal information?

Do we share or disclose your personal information?

We will NOT disclose personal information about you (including your identity) to a third party unless we are required to do so in the course of legal proceedings or other investigations, or if we determine that the disclosure is necessary in connection with a complaint regarding your use of the website or when we use the services of third parties to administer this website.





How long do we hold personal information?

We will keep your personal information for only as long as is necessary to achieve the purpose for which we collected it.

What are cookies and do we use them?
